



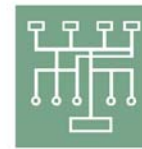

FERRY ROAD, ILLINOIS RTE 59 TO EOLA ROAD PHASE 1 STUDY AND PHASE II DESIGN

HOH was responsible for a Phase I Design Study and Phase II Design of Ferry Road from IL 59 to Eola Road a distance of 2 miles. The Phase 1 study developed a new alignment for Ferry Road and a new wider typical cross section to accommodate development planned for the area. The project also includes new traffic signals at the intersections of Ferry Road with Illinois Route 59 and with Eola Road.

The design work included geometrics, drainage and detention storage, profile studies, right of way need determinations, intersection design studies, traffic data analysis, wetland mitigation, a pedestrian/equestrian bridge over the new Ferry Road along the Prairie Path, a new bridge over the E J & E Railroad, transmission tower relocation and major pipelines impacts and protection.

The project area includes the communities of Warrenville, Naperville and Aurora. Public coordination was very active, culminating in a transfer of jurisdiction of Ferry Road from the three communities to DuPage County.
