

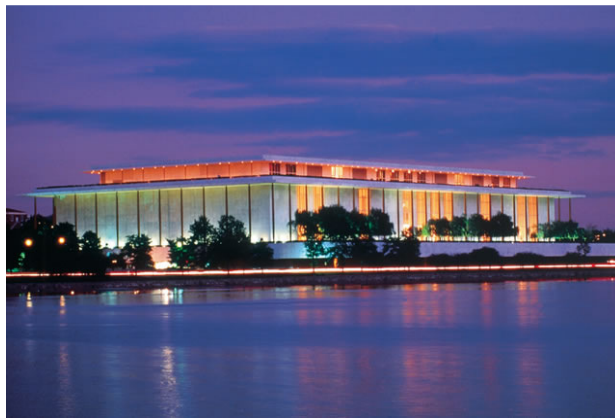


FIRE ALARM SYSTEM CONSULTING SERVICES

A new multiplex addressable analog fire alarm system has been installed in the Kennedy Center for Performing Arts. The new fire alarm system consisted of

- Fire Detection System
- One-way Voice System
- Two-way Voice System
- Sprinkler Monitoring
- Fire Command Center
- Remote Annunciation
- Auxiliary control



HOH provided design and construction support for the new fire alarm system in the Kennedy Center for performing Arts in Washington D.C. This project replaced a proprietary coded fire alarm system with a state of the art analog addressable multiplex fire alarm system. The fire alarm system upgrades also included major renovations projects; the North and South Garage expansion project, Opera House renovation and Kitchen renovation.

The construction services required a monitoring of a phased installation of the new fire alarm system while maintaining the existing coded fire alarm system until the new fire alarm system could be tested, accepted and Kennedy Center personnel trained to respond to the new fire alarm system.

HOH also provided consultation services writing specification for the maintenance and testing service contracts on the fire protection equipment, upgrades on the existing sprinkler system and providing electrically operated flow testing devices on the existing sprinkler system that did not have provisions for testing the floor and area water flow switches.
