



VANDERPOEL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FIRE ALARM SYSTEM

CHICAGO PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM



HOH provided design, bid documents and engineering construction support for a new fire alarm system at Vanderpoel Elementary School. This project was part of an ADA upgrade for the school. The fire alarm system was designed in accordance with Chicago Building Codes, NFPA 72 and ADA Accessibility Guidelines for Building and Facilities (ADAAG). The system also included cross-zoning addressable smoke detection for the elevator recall.

In-order to avoid school downtime or shutdown, the new system was put in operation in parallel with the existing one. The existing system was removed after the new system was made operational and received City of Chicago approved.
